The list has been approved by the Vermont Bird Records Committee and includes 378 species representing 18 orders and 58 families of birds. The names of the birds and their taxonomic arrangement follow the American Ornithologists' Union Check-list of North American Birds Seventh Edition (1998), 50th supplement (July 2009).
